2015 Gourd Trial – Common Wealth Seed Growers Conducted by Sapphyre Miria and Edmund Frost at Twin Oaks Seed Farm

29 varieties were direct seeded on May 12th, and thinned to three plants per variety on June 8th. Tomato cages were used to provide partial trellis. Row spacing was 12 feet, and varieties were spaced 15 feet apart in-row. Plants were rated for Downy Mildew on foliage on August 29th, on a 1-9 scale, 1 being unaffected and 9 being completely dead. Downy Mildew resistance mostly corresponded to %usable fruits. The varieties with the best DMR included Bule, African Drum, Extra Long Handled Dipper, Mayo Warty Bule, Mayo Bule Warty, Bule Smooth Offtype, and Tarahaumara Dipper.

We intended to record another DM foliage rating in late September but did not. However, we noted before frost in mid October that the above varieties plus Dinosaur/Maranka were the only ones still at least somewhat healthy. During the month of September, Miniature Bottle Gourd, Giant African Water Bottle and Chickasaw Bogue Gourd vines died back, removing them from consideration as DMR varieties.

Gourds are a very long season crop. Healthy foliage throughout their lifespan is essential to producing usable and good quality gourds. Varieties susceptible to Downy Mildew can lose 1-2 months of growing time, resulting in unusable fruits.
